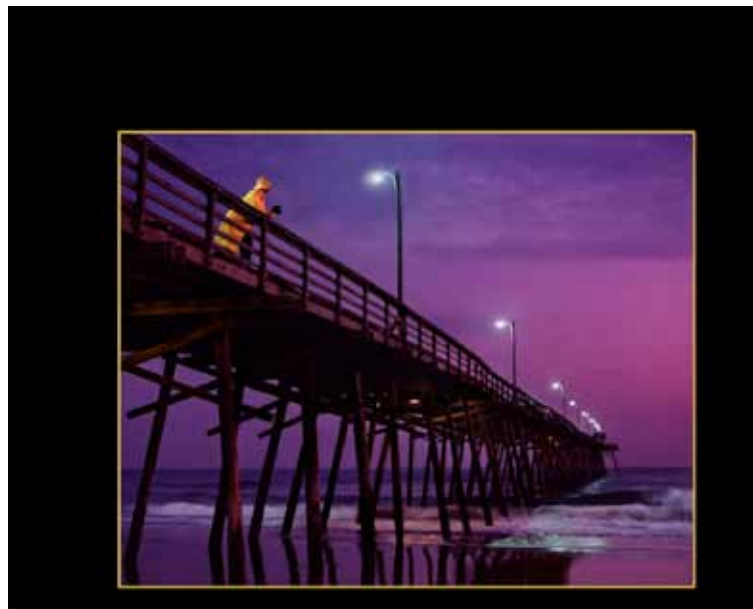


Biography:

Mark Campbell, M.Photog., Cr., CPP, API, has owned and operated Prestige Photography & Video in Wheeling, West Virginia with his wife Cheryl since 1989. He is a past president of both the Triangle Photographers Association and the Professional Photographers of West Virginia. He also represents West Virginia on PPA's National Council and either chairs or serves on several PPA committees, including the By-Laws, Rules & Ethics Committee. Mark is also a PPA Approved Photographic Instructor.

Mark teaches a variety of digital, photo and sales techniques. He has presented programs for numerous professional photography groups throughout the US as well as Fine Arts Centers and school systems. He has represented Color labs at national trade shows as a calibration and color management expert and has represented Epson in several capacities. He was the number one photographer in West Virginia's 2002 print competition and his very first entry into PPA National competition, "Fisherman's Wharf" appeared on the 2002 Loan Book cover. Since then he has won many competition awards including 3 Kodak Gallery and 2 Fuji Masterpiece Awards. In 2005 Mark was presented with The National Award - PPA's highest service award.

His specialties include Adobe Photoshop® (for which he is an Adobe Certified Expert), and a host of related third-party software. Among the PPA affiliates he has taught at are: **Triangle Institute, GLIP, PPSNY, The Florida School, Heart of America**, Professional Photographers of **West Virginia**, Professional Photographers Association of **Pennsylvania**, Professional Photographers of **Ohio**, the **Virginia** Professional Photographers Association, the **Maryland** Professional Photographers Association, The **Delaware** Professional Photographers and the Professional Photographers Guild of Delaware Valley in **Philadelphia**. In addition, he has been invited to many local and regional organizations as well as private studios covering the entire eastern US. Perhaps the most telling statistic is that he has been asked to speak at most of these organizations numerous times.
